Tickets are now available to next weekend's concert, an "Invitation to the Dance." Priority seating is also available, and kids are free. Hope to see you there!

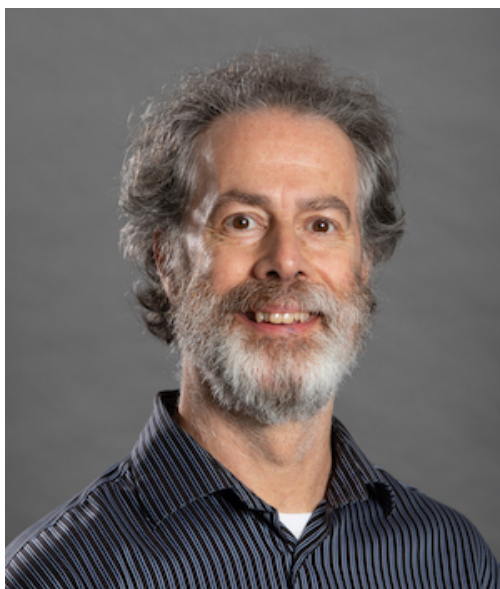

Marquez - Danzon No. 2

A modern classic inspired by a Cuban dance, Danzon No. 2 by Mexican composer [Arturo Márquez](#) is one of the most frequently performed Mexican contemporary classical orchestral pieces. It was commissioned by the University of Mexico in 1994.

Fun fact: The piece formed the basis of a short film made in 2009. The film is set in Mexico City in the 1940s, during the time the "danzon" was popular, and is about a love triangle. It even features Márquez himself in a cameo as the pianist of a dance-hall! [Check it out here.](#)



Symphony Spotlight: Lydia Park

Lydia Park, a Milwaukee native, developed a love for the cello at an early age. She participated in the MYSO and youth chamber ensembles until she graduated high school. She attended Lawrence University and the UW Stevens Point, where she completed her undergraduate degree in Cello Performance. She received her master's degree in Cello Performance and a certificate in Cello Pedagogy at Colorado State University. There, she was also the cellist in the CSU Graduate String Quartet and Managing Director for the

Fort Collins All-City High School Honor Orchestra. Lydia performed as a section player in the annual Colorado Mahlerfest, Opera Steamboat, Bel Canto Chorus, Longmont Symphony, Cheyenne Symphony, Front Range Chamber Players, and The Chippewa Valley Symphony. She taught cello in Eau Claire, Wisconsin, Fort Collins, CO, and at The String Academy of Wyoming in Laramie, WY. Welcome to the Kettle Moraine Symphony, Lydia!
